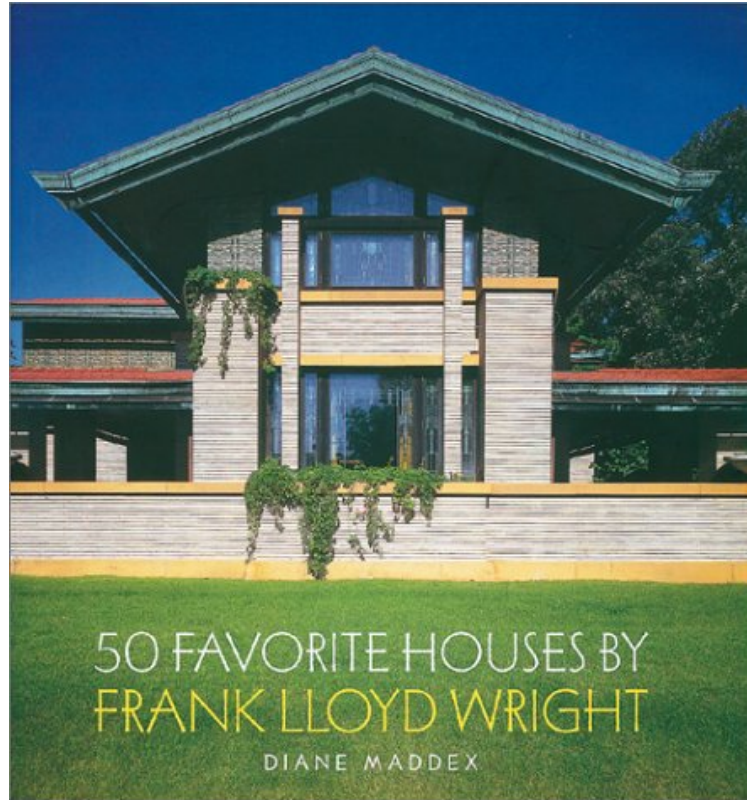

Virtually every photo is an exterior shot mostly giving you a feeling of the building in the context of its setting. One of the only large FLW photo books with no black and white photos, the one photo of him being in color which is pretty rare. The book does leave ya feeling that you want more. At 128 pages it's not thin like some of the under 100 page big FLW books but it's not hefty either, that's for sure. It's nicely done. I see that trees are prominent in almost each picture. It is nice to also have a book of just his homes. When presented together in one book without the churches, public or corporate buildings you get a feeling of a tone he set for homes. The homes photographed in the midst of their settings gives you a real sense of how it looks to come up to each of these homes, some in snow, and how they belong in their environment.
