I'm still trying to learn how to use the damn thing, but so far my verdict is a real book far outweighs this electronic garbage where you can't just flip to the page you want, you have to go page by page, and so if what you want is on page 54 you have to flip through 54 pages, which can take up to 5 minutes to get to.Information is lackluster at best, had expected more advanced information.
