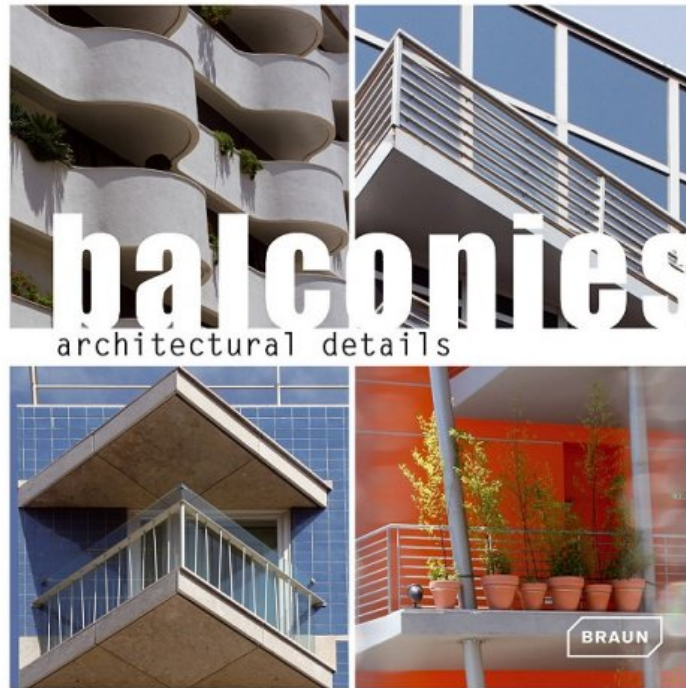

And that's really what the book aspires to be. Flipping though the pages I can't help thinking these photographers visited these places without much research and instead just walked around a few days taking random pictures from the street. Next to a few interesting or inspiring examples, most are not. The book lacks cohesiveness, analysis and proper project information. The study of urban balconies deserves a more thorough approach than this.
