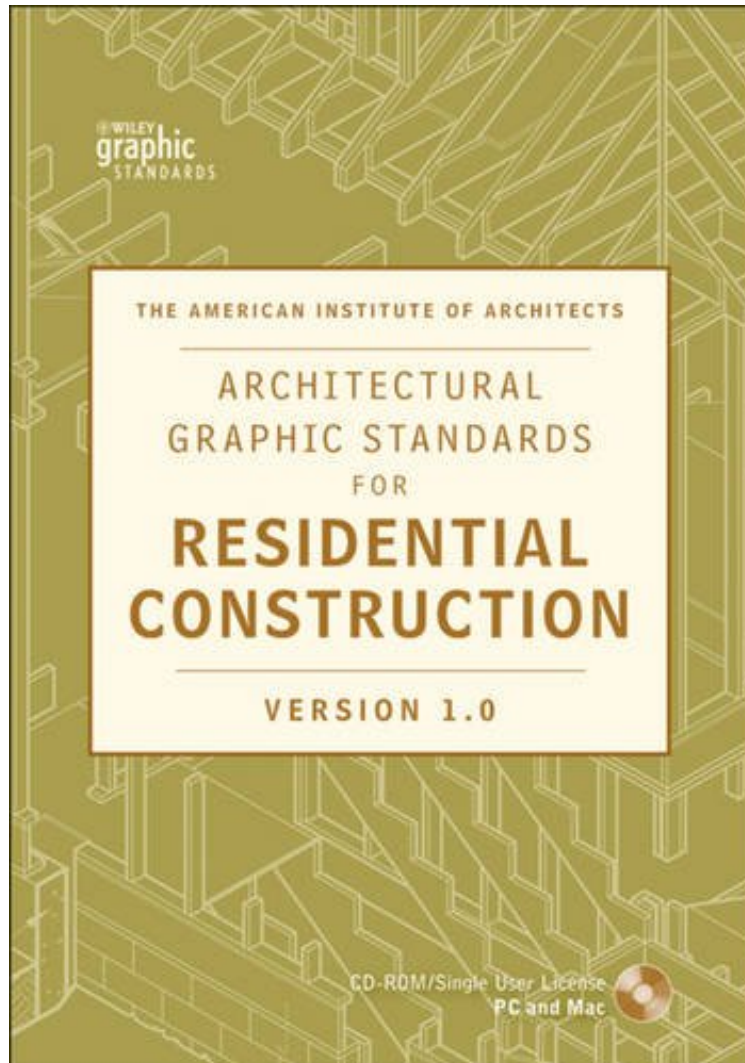

Then I go and download. I'm using AutoCAD Revit 2013 and about half of the drawings don't come out well, even when completely exploded. I think these drawings may work better with just plain AutoCAD. Many times I just use a PDF if I don't have to do any alterations to the drawing

itself (and then turn the PDF into a JPEG and insert an image and scale it). What I do like about it is that it corresponds nicely to what is in the book.
