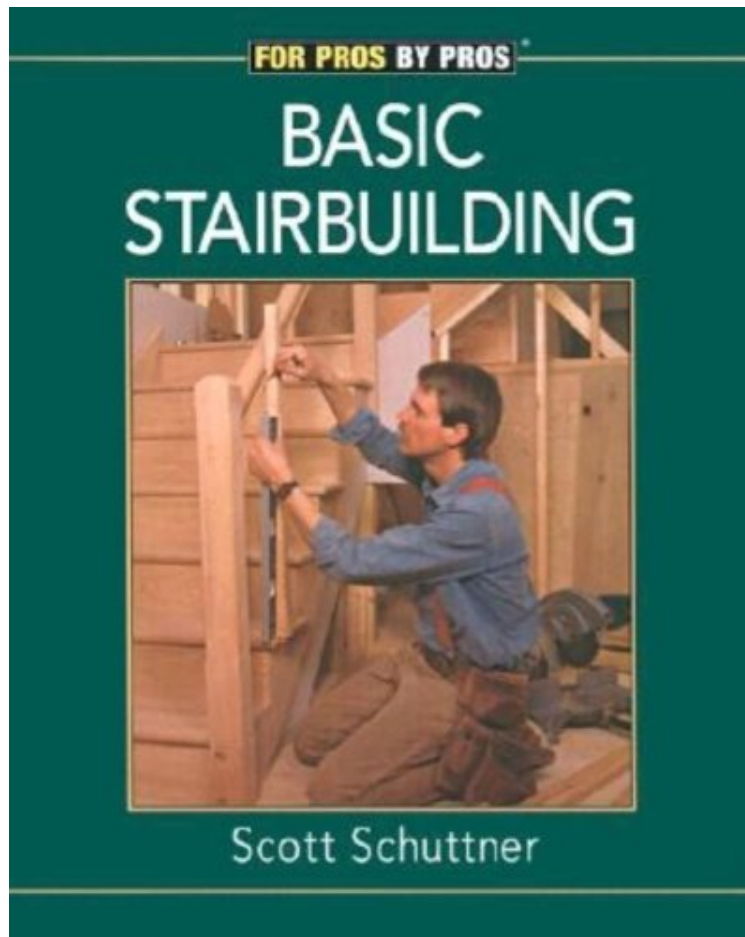

Mr. Schuttner explains in substantial detail the steps necessary to build a basic staircase, which can appear to be a daunting task indeed! If you're just replacing the entry stairs on a dwelling; building a grand, intricate staircase in a new home; or just building a form for concrete stairs; consulting this book can help prevent you from making common mistakes, such as not adding the thickness of the treads when cutting the stringers. Whether you're an experienced carpenter, a "Weekend-Warrior" DIY person, or someone that is unsure of the difference between a hammer and a screwdriver, you will find this book to be like a wonderful accessory for your toolbelt. As for me, I relearned some building practices I was exposed to back during my childhood.Sometimes, Mr. Schuttner gets a little long-winded when explaining some things; yet, I would rather have more information than woefully not enough. A staircase isn't easy to upgrade later when more time and money are available;" ...
