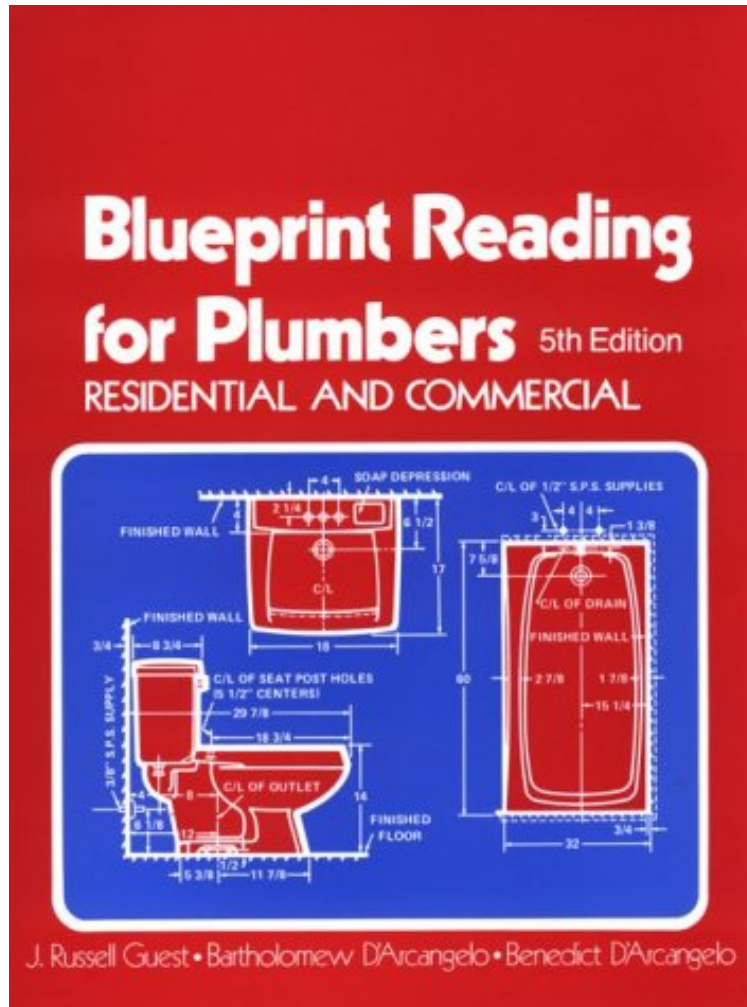

Binter This is an excellent workbook with questions at the end of each chapter. Imagine my surprise when the book has no answers to the questions so you can check your work! I am helping a young gentleman study for his master plumbing exam, and am a University of Vermont Asst Prof, but unfortunately that doesn't count. Very Frustrating!

This one-of-a-kind text develops the ability to interpret trade blueprints and to plan the installation of the required plumbing. All content in this edition has been updated to the latest code, pipe and fitting materials, and fixture design.
