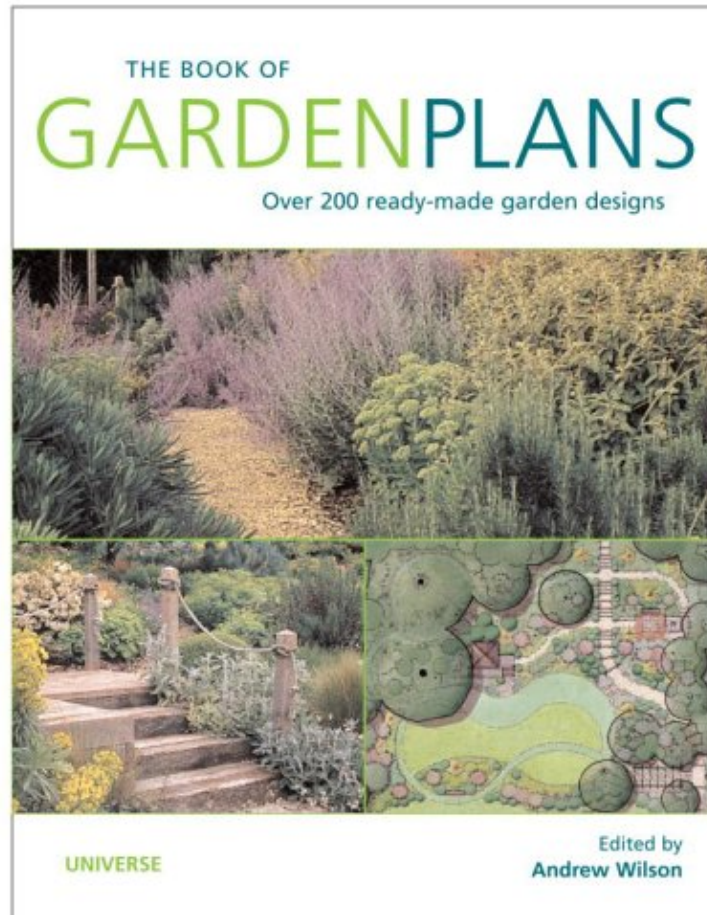

There is a rather fuzzy architect drawing, one TINY picture of some obscure part of the garden (one picture is actually just a close up of a small portion of a birch tree!), and a 2-3 paragraph blurb. That is all there is to see of any one design. As a professional gardener, I do not find any of this helpful. The detail is hardly clear enough to decipher. The sample picture is useless, and the script is not enough to be of use.
