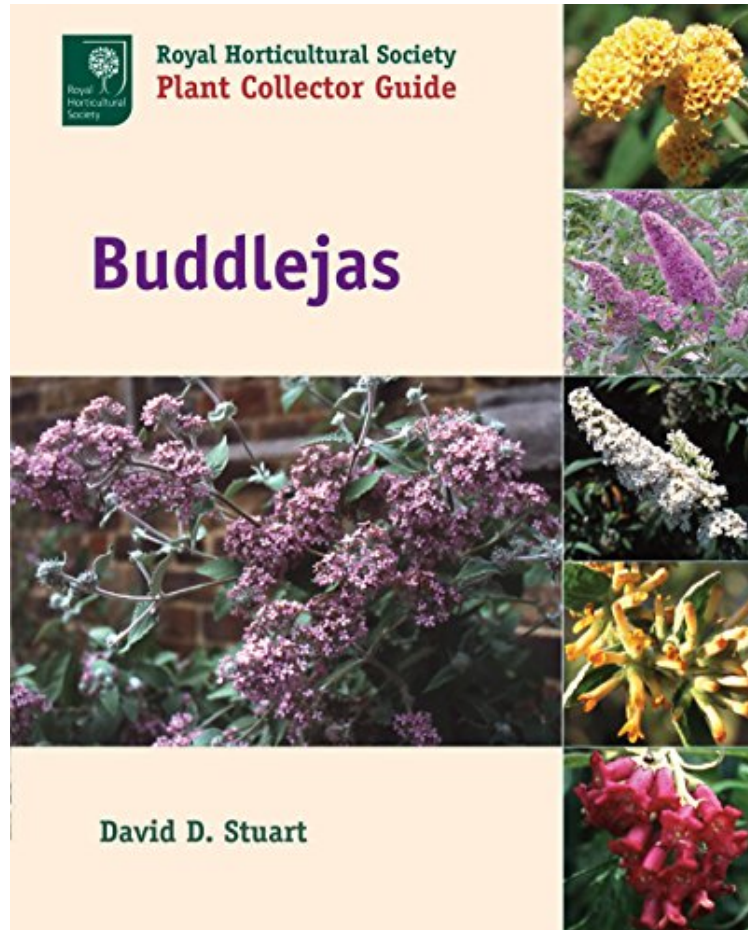

Unlike some books (Betty Clebsch's book on *Salvia* springs to mind) this is a rather dry treatment of *Buddlejas*. The RHS badge gives it gravitas but the writing style is not very engaging and its almost a botanical treatise. Having been a botanist myself I can see the difference between the styles of writing! Nevertheless, it is the only book on this fascinating genus and, is hadnsomely produced.
