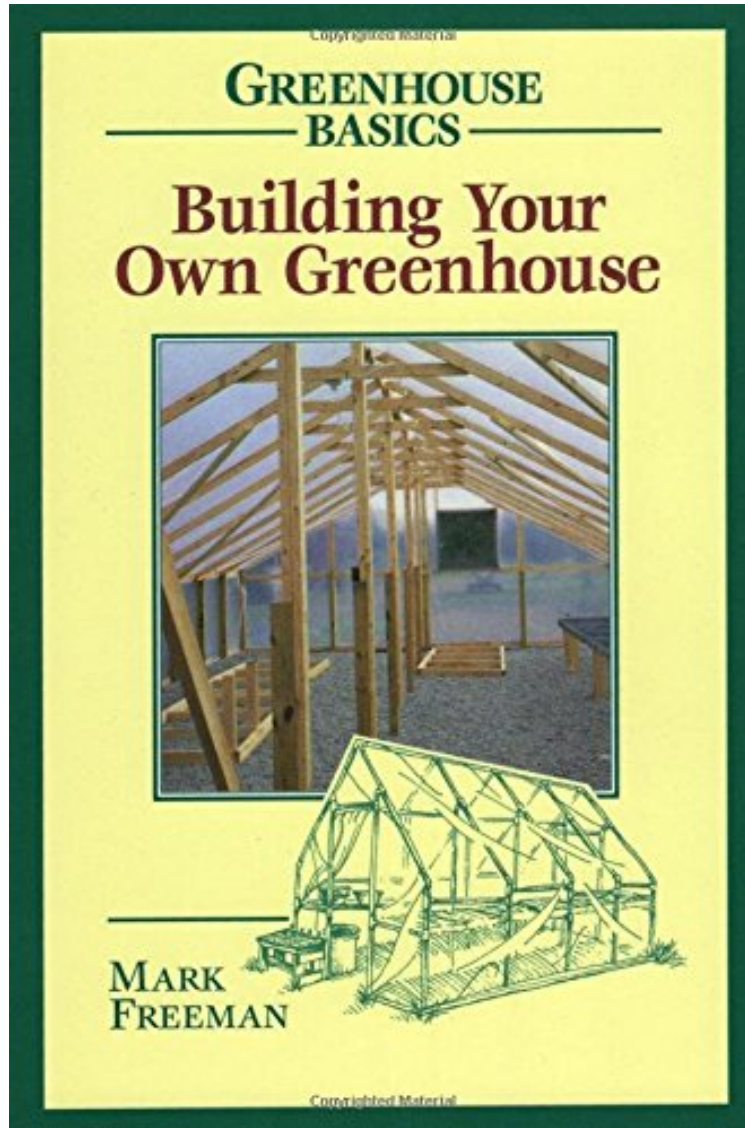

It is, however, very informative concerning the following: things to consider in the dreaming stages, very useful in planning, very helpful in choosing among types of greenhouses, gives many examples of actual greenhouses, both attached and freestanding, good descriptions of materials available and approximate costs in the late 1990's, upsides and downsides of the choices one will make.

What you don't learn from the title is that Chapter 10 is a good discussion of hotbeds and coldframes. I will be building a greenhouse to extend the growing season for my tomatoes, eggplants, chili peppers and tomatillos. I will also be building a hotbed for growing seedlings to get a jump on the growing season. This book has really helped me to sort all of that out and make key decisions about what and how to build. I read it, nearly cover to cover, in two days.
