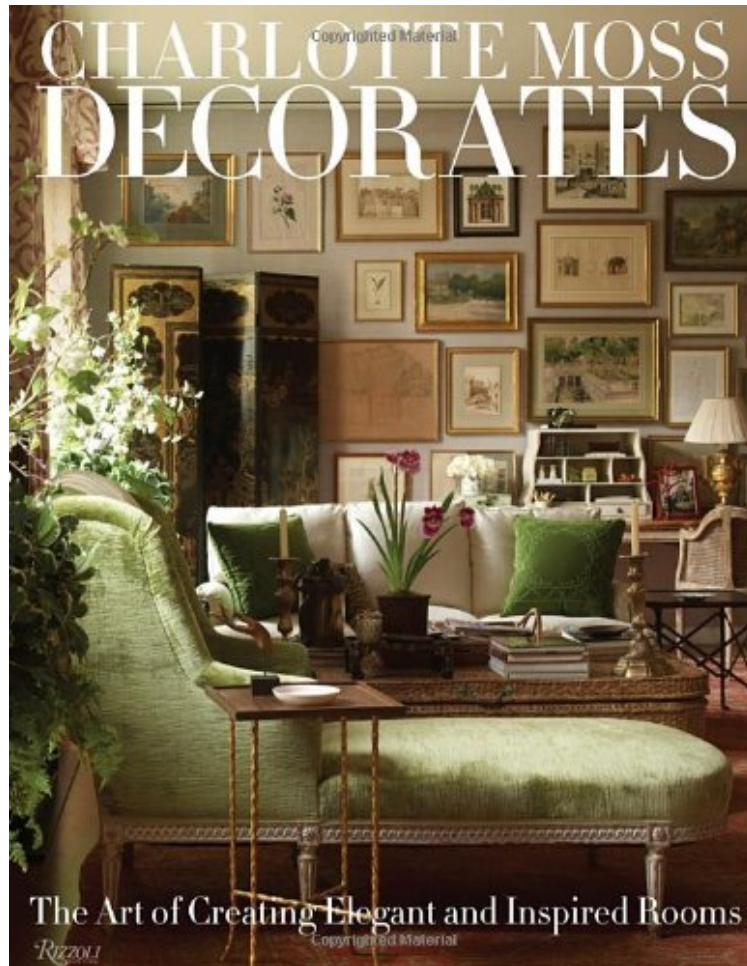

introduction that shares Charlotte's inspiration for the room. There is a collage for each room, and similar to other reviews the collage did nothing for me and I quickly turned the page. There are numerous photos for each room, all beautiful and high quality. Each section concludes with a page or two of 'why not's' that serves to highlight some of the key aspects of the room.
